After a lengthy meeting with a representative from the Town of Southeast and the Town of Patterson regarding the closing of Pugsley Road all parties came to an agreement. It is the position of the Putnam County Sheriff's Office that the proposed gates along with the turnaround shall be constructed as indicated on the original plans. The gates will remain opened and signage will be installed prohibiting commercial vehicles with the exception of local deliveries to resident's only and limiting traffic to residents only. This will be enforced and should enforcement not be a deterrent the gates will be secured and the roadway closed.

The proposal of installing a 12' high crash bar was never brought to the table during our meeting. It is the position of the Putnam County Sheriff's Office that the installations of a 12' high crash bar cannot and will not be considered an option. Firstly, this would create an issue for emergency fire apparatus and secondly, it would not be aesthetically pleasing with the environment along Pugsley Road.
