Opens Memorial Weekend for weekends only through June 25<sup>th</sup>.  
Noon to 5:00 p.m.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Tonetta Lake is open for use by RESIDENTS of the Town of Southeast and residents of Patterson whose children are enrolled in the Brewster Central School District. The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all users. They have been established to ensure safe and sanitary operation of all facilities. All persons are to obey the rules, regulations and instructions at all times. Parents are requested to read and explain these rules to their children and caution them to observe all rules. Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of privileges of the offending person and may also be considered sufficient cause for the cancellation of IDENTIFICATION CARD.

#### GENERAL RULES

1. Each resident must present their identification card at the entrance when entering Tonetta Lake.  
**No one will be allowed through the gate without a CARD even if known by the attendant in charge.**  
When requested by the attendant other proper identification must be shown.
2. Permitting anyone to use your card will be sufficient cause for revoking it for the season.
3. The Recreation Leader should be notified immediately upon loss of identification card. Application for a replacement should be made at the Recreation Office at a cost of \$5.00 per card.
4. All persons using any of the recreation facilities do so at their own risk. The Town Board will NOT be responsible for any accident or injury.
5. The Town Board will NOT be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property.
6. All persons using the recreation facilities shall observe such rules as posted in the area
7. NO INTOXICANTS may be brought into or consumed in the area.
8. No abusive language shall be used.
9. No PETS are allowed in the recreation areas.
10. Park groups planning any activities at the recreation areas must obtain permission from the Recreation Leader.
11. Admission to the Beach area shall be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or wearing bandages.
12. Boat launching is not allowed off Town Property.
13. SPECIAL GUEST PERMITS: Each family unit may purchase at any time only TWO sets of ten reduced price passes at \$25.00 each, when they have purchased their season pass. Only 5 passes may be used on any given day. Residents utilizing a daily pass that wish to bring guests will be limited to 5 guests per family per day.  
**RESIDENTS MUST ACCOMPANY GUESTS!** SENIOR CITIZEN GUEST PASS - TWO sets of ten reduced price passes at \$25.00 each for "GRANDCHILDREN ONLY" (only 5 passes may be used per day)
15. **NO SMOKING ON TOWN FACILITIES.**
16. No Floatation devices permitted. Zip-up preserves and swimmies are permitted in the roped area.
17. **Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an Adult 21 years of age**
18. Children 16 years of age and over must have proof of residency. School ID with address and/or Report card.
