***Consent forms must be completed prior to clinic.**

Cost: \$30.00

(65 and older or with Medicare Card – FREE)

Appointments are Required.

Please bring proof of residency (driver's license) and Medicare card.

The Putnam County Department of Health will be offering **High Dose Flu Vaccine** for seniors age 65 and older. Studies have shown this vaccine appears more effective in fighting flu in seniors.

Pneumonia vaccine will not be available at clinics this year.
